GO:0070269 pyroptosis

- There were objections to this obsoletion, accompanied by suggestions for papers to be annotated. Here's a summary:
- "[As of 17/11/2011] There are 81 references in Pubmed that refer to this term, including mechanistic studies and the definition of a "pyroptosome" (PMID: 17599095 and 6 other references). ...clearly this is an area of much recent research, with over half the references published in the last 22 months. ... look at the papers ... such as PMID:21804020 or PMID:21687424 or PMID:20417169".
- Can this be a part of the apoptosis curation effort (once the main apoptosis GO structure is in place)?
