Accomplished today



- 1. To present the most recent proposed guidelines for binding term annotations to the GOC
 - GOC has ratified the proposed guidelines, recognizing that editing required
- 2. To discuss aspects of guidelines which have not been agreed by working group
 - Do not separate substrate binding from effector binding
 - Do not use IC (inferred by curator) to add a binding term annotation if a enzyme/transporter activity is present which covers this statement
 - ISS/ISO and 'binding' terms, this is not well represented, alternatives need to be considered
 - How much information to include in GO? Not discussed today
 - Boundary between binding and catalysis. Not discussed today



Future Action items



- Edit the binding term annotation guidelines in line with comments from discussion and distribute to Pl's for approval and then include in guidelines
- Identify areas of controversy and discuss within working group, eg:
 - Remove binding term if EXP confirms enzyme activity
 - Consider how to improve protein binding ISS
 - What substrates to include in GO?
 - Type of relationship between activity and binding
 - statement in definition?
 - parent/child relationship?....
- Find examples to help illustrate guidelines
